Letter from the Rector

March 1, 2008

Dear Friends,

It is hard to believe we are half-way through Lent and March is just coming in like a lion. When I was in New Orleans, we didn't like early Lent because it generally meant that the weather would be bad for Mardi Gras (this year was an exception—the last weekend of Mardi Gras was great, although it did rain on Fat Tuesday), but we loved an early Easter because it could be very warm when Easter fell in the middle to late period of April. In the northeast an early Easter can mean snow; we will hope not this year.

I do want to let you know about Holy Week and Easter at Christ Church. Palm Sunday is the 16th of March. We will be doing the full liturgy of that day, but we are going to have our Sunday School help us with the Palm Gospel and the St. Matthew Passion, which will be 'acted-out.' We have started work on the 'productions' and hope they will help all of us better appreciate the richness of the two gospel narratives. The church is quiet throughout Holy Week. We will have Morning Prayer only on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

On Maundy Thursday (the word 'Maundy' comes from the old English, based on the Latin 'Mandatum,' which means mandate (or commandment), noting the Gospel of John 13:34 in which Jesus gives to his disciples a *novum mandatum* (new commandment) that they should 'love one another even as I have loved you.') we note Jesus love for his disciples, his church and his people when we remember the washing of his disciples' feet (the *pedilevium*) and the institution of the Last Supper. In addition to Morning Prayer, we will have a celebration of the Holy Eucharist at 10:00 AM and the full liturgy of Maundy Thursday at 7:30 PM, including the stripping of the altar. After the 7:30 PM service the church will remain open until 10:00 PM, with the reserved sacrament placed in the chapel until distributed at the services on Good Friday.

On Good Friday the church will be opened at 9:00AM. We will say Morning Prayer at the opening of the church and the church will be open for prayer and meditation throughout the day. At noon and again at 7:30 PM we will the Liturgy for Good Friday with the reading of the John Passion, the Solemn Collects. At noon there will be distribution of the Holy Communion from the reserved sacrament; there will be no distribution at the 7:30 PM service. The church will be closed after the later service and will remained closed until Easter morning.

Our Easter services will be at 9:30 AM and 11:15 AM. The 9:30 service will be a Family Eucharist with a telling of the meaning of the Easter story for children. The service will be 45 minutes in duration. Following the Family Eucharist there will be an Easter egg (read chocolate) hunt. The 11:15 AM service will be a Festal Eucharist with choir, organ and brass (the Mass setting will be *Missa secunda* by Hans Leo Hassler and motets by Edward Bairstow and John Naylor will be sung. Pre-service music will start at 11:00 AM.

Please also note within the *Chart* the full list of worship and educational activities at Christ Church during Lent and Easter.

Parish Notes:

Sunshine Ministry:

With the departure of Marianne Templeton to parts north, we failed to get our report about the wonderful work of the Sunshine Ministry into the Christ Church *Annual Report*. The Sunshine Ministry writes the many wonderful greetings that we all receive at our birthdays and wedding anniversaries and the get-well wishes when we are sick. In addition to Marianne's work in creating the Sunshine Ministry group, the work is carried out by Lettie Snodgrass, Amy Angus, Burr Henahan and Anne McIntosh. To keep-up with the writing of notes and greetings, the Sunshine Ministry can use additional volunteers. Although the group usually meets following the Thursday morning Eucharist, it is possible to have notes written at home and left-off on Sundays to be mailed the following week. Youth Group:

There is good news and bad news about our youth ministry: the good news is that we have many extraordinarily successful and busy young people; the bad news is that it has proven very difficult to get together with our young people. We are going to try a different approach: get-togethers on the second Sunday each month a 4:00 PM for special programs and a simple dinner. The first meeting will be on Sunday, April 12. More details will be in the April *Chart*. There will be no further Thursday meetings.

♪ Music notes:

As we progress through Lent, it is worth recalling that the organ plays a limited role in services. It has been a longstanding Church tradition to reduce the use of musical instruments during Lent and especially during Holy Week. Accordingly, here at Christ Church, during Lent, postludes are omitted, and the preludes are of a meditative character. Also, there are no organ improvisations following the reading of the Gospel or at any other point during services. After Maundy Thursday, the organ is not played again until Easter Day, when it is heard in all of its fullness. On Easter, the music will be supplemented by a brass quartet and timpani. The addition of these wonderful instruments will help us express, with the utmost exuberance, Christ's resurrection. The choir will also sing an unaccompanied Mass setting by Hans Leo Hassler and an anthem by Edward Bairstow.

Beginning in January, we instituted some changes in the organization of our Junior Choir. The choir now meets immediately following each Sunday's 10 a. m. service, at the back of the church. We rehearse for approximately thirty minutes, focusing on music fundamentals, such as reading music, sight-reading music, and voice production. This will enable each chorister to have a more thorough understanding of the music they learn. As a result, the choir will sing less frequently but, in turn, hopefully have a more profound appreciation of music in general. I encourage all youth to think about joining this choir.

Please mark two special dates on your calendars. The first is an evensong service, sung by both our Junior and Adult Choirs, at the Church of Saint Mary the Virgin in New York City (145 West 46th Street, between 6th and 7th Avenues). This service begins at 5 p.m. on Sunday, April 27. All are invited. St. Mary's is a marvelous acoustical space, and its services are quite elaborate and beautiful. The second service, involving the same forces and music, will be repeated at Christ Church on Sunday, May 4, at 5 p. m. These are sure to be inspiring services. Please plan to attend one or both!

Finally, we welcome a new member to our choir. Vaughn Fritts, our new bass section leader, began singing with us a few weeks ago. Please welcome him (and his wonderful, resonant bass voice) to Christ Church.
