Dear Friends,

We are trying to get the *Chart* out a little early to remind everyone of the Sunday School awards, the parish picnic and a reception for Kyle Babin this Sunday, June 1 at and after the 10:00 AM service. I would also like to make a plea for additional e-mail addresses so we can contact as many people as possible about parish events which come up between issues of the *Chart*.

Beginning on Sunday, June 8 we will move to our Summer schedule. With Easter so early this year, the major holy days that conclude our Easter celebration (Ascension, Pentecost and Trinity) have come in May. We will continue to have celebrations of the Holy Eucharist at 8:00 and 10:00 AM as well as 6:00 PM. However, we will cease having the 9:30 AM *Pro-anaphora* for the children in the Parish House Chapel.

On Wednesday, June 25 we will start our Home Communion and pot-luck dinners. It seemed to work well to have the Eucharist in homes (rather than on the Christ Church grounds), so we will continue that practice. I have invited another parish to consider participating with us, which would allow us to meet some old friends again—and make some new church friends as well. The first Home Communion will be at the Christ Church Rectory (54 George Street). If you would be interested in hosting a Home Communion, please call the parish office (627-2184) or sign-up on the sheet in the church.

I would also like to update you on the sale of a portion of the campus and the senior housing project. The developer (Gothic Church LLC) has withdrawn its application for a zoning change on the property in order to make significant changes in its plan for the property. As you are probably aware, the church's neighbors and many in the local community raised concerns about the size of the senior housing project and its location on the Christ Church campus. Gothic Church met with the neighbors and had a productive session. Agreement was reached on the footprint of the building and the architects are working on drawings of the revised plan. These plans will be brought back to the neighbors for their input. When there is basic agreement among the neighbors, the church and the developer about how the campus will be restructured, there will be meetings with organizations in the larger Manhasset community prior to re-submission of the plan to the Town of North Hempstead. This will delay the overall process and we are in the process of renegotiating the contract with Gothic Church to the mutual benefit of the church and the developer. It is hoped that funds from the escrow on the sale of the property will be liberated immediately which will allow Christ Church to finish necessary repairs on the tower at the church and waterproofing of the church building.

Finally, with the resignation of Kyle Babin as Christ Church organist/choirmaster we are in the process of searching for a new person to fill his position. Over the coming three weeks the music committee will interview three candidates for the position. All three have been highly recommended for the position. We have every hope that we will fill the position of organist/choirmaster by the beginning of July.

This comes with best wishes for a pleasant conclusion to the school year and a restful early summer.

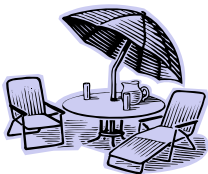


### Sunday and Thursday Services remain the same for Summer
