Letter from the Rector

August 1, 2010

Dear Friends,

What a summer it has been! Last summer was one of the most pleasant in memory; this summer has been one of the warmest and driest summers in history. I suspect the weather has interrupted the pleasantries of summer for many of us and has made summer 're-creation' more difficult for many of us. Nonetheless, I hope your summer has been as good as possible.

We have remained busy at Christ Church. We are half-way through our Home Communion schedule. They have been most wonderful this summer. Attendance has been high, the fellowship warm and the food great-many thanks to the Sieners, the McDowells and the Schmidts for their kind hospitality. The Home Communions continue through the end of August on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 PM. The schedule for August can be found in the *Chart*.

We are also well into our summer education programs. On Monday evenings we are looking at the basics of our faith. This is not a straight-forward 'telling' of our faith; it is rather a probing of what religion is (much of it good and some of it not-so-good) and how our faith directs our lives—personal, familial and societal. We start with a light supper at 7:00 PM and go on from there. It is never too late to join our discussions. On Tuesday evenings we are probing the seven accounts of creation in the Old Testament. These diverse stories of how our cosmos came to be tell much about the concept of God, earth and ecology. We have considered two accounts of creation in Genesis and one in the Book of Job. Over the coming weeks we will look at accounts from the books of Psalms (Psalm 104), Ecclesiastes, Wisdom of Solomon and Isaiah. There have been (and will be more) surprises in these diverse stories of how we came to be!

We are also in the process of looking at our Sunday schedule to enhance our worship and education experiences. In the coming weeks we will be reviewing possible changes with our Church School teachers and the Vestry and look forward to sharing with you our recommendations.

I hope you will have cool and relaxing August and will be refreshed for a busy Fall.
