Letter from the Rector

August 1, 2011

Dear Friends

In spite of the past week's record breaking hot weather, I hope that you are having a pleasant and restful summer. It is hard to believe that we are approaching the halfway point for the summer vacation time. Although the return to school is not just around the corner it is not far away either.

At Christ Church thoughts are turning toward the return of the school year and the fall season. The first Sunday of the Fall Schedule will be Sunday, September 11. Church School will officially begin that day with our annual *Ice Cream Sunday* and the Christ Church Choir will return to sing with us. On Sunday, September 25, we will have a very special "Christ Church Day" with the visit of the new Bishop of Long Island for Baptism and Confirmation at the 10am service. Although Christ Church has entertained two visiting Bishops over the past years, this will be the first official of the Bishop of Long Island at Christ Church since 2003. We hope that this will be a time the entire Christ Church family will come together to greet Bishop Provenzano and to support the first Confirmations held in Christ Church since May of 1995. We will have more information about that special day in the September Chart.

We have made good progress during the last three months with the planned renovation of the Parish Hall and the sale of part of the Christ Church property. Meetings with the Town of North Hempstead and the neighbors of Christ Church have allowed the developer to refine the plans for the property in such a way that will be positive for the developer, Christ Church and our neighbors. We expect that there will be the first hearing before the town board in early September and it is hoped that the zoning changes necessary for the redevelopment of the property will be granted by the end of the year. This will allow the formal subdivision of the property to take place and the closing on the property. When the closing takes place Christ Church will receive \$3.1 million for the property but of that \$3.1 million, \$1.6 million will be credited back to the developer to cover the cost of the renovation of the portion of the Parish House that will become the Christ Church Parish Hall as well as the renovation of the Rectory. Although Christ Church will continue to own a major portion of the parking areas, north and west of the Parish House, maintenance of all the parking areas, as well as, landscaping for the area will be the sole responsibility of the developer.

It is expected that it will be approximately 10 months from now that all building permits will be granted and renovation of the Parish House will begin. We expect to have access to the Parish House and all the property until the end of the 2011/2012 school year. We have been working on contingency plans for the time when we will not have access to the Parish House. We will continue to weigh our options as the process of zoning and subdivision changes and building permits come to fruition. We will not have access to the Parish House for a period of at least 14 months after renovations begin.

Please do keep the Christ Church parish family and especially the Vestry of Christ Church in your prayers during this special time in the life of the Christ Church Parish.

Rector's Schedule for the Second Week of August.

The Rector will be away on from Monday, August 15 through Wednesday, August 17 inclusive. There will not be a celebration of the Holy Eucharist and on Wednesday morning and the evening Bible Study is also cancelled. Morning Prayer and Evening Prayer will resume on **Thursday, August 18** and our Wednesday morning Eucharist will resume again on **August 24** as will the Wednesday evening Bible Study.

Please feel free to join us on Wednesday evenings at 7:30pm as we work our way through the fascinating Book of the Acts of the Apostles written by Luke, a companion of the Apostle Paul and the author of the Gospel by that name. It is on one level the history of the early church. On another level it is a complex theological treatise of the meaning of faith in a changing world. Written in about the year 80 A.D. it recalls events from 30 or more years earlier than the time in which the text was written down. From the time of the events recorded to the time of the writing down of those recollections the City of Jerusalem and the Temple were destroyed in a war between Jewish Zealots and Roman occupiers. The church had migrated from its roots in Jerusalem to the broader landscape of the enforced Jewish Diaspora and Gentile followers of the faith. The Acts of the Apostles reflects the theological dynamism and the cultural struggles of the church during a time of radical social, cultural and religious change. Because of the context in which the Acts of the Apostles was written, it is a fascinating study for our faith and our churches in the time of rapid social cultural and religious changes in our contemporary world. Please come and join us for this journey through faith and history.
