## Letter from the Rector

August 1, 2012

Dear Friends,

Summer is almost half over and in about a month Labor Day will usher in a new school year. We use the end of the summer to prepare for the new school and church year. This year is no exception—except that our preparations for the 2012-2013 Sunday school year will be extraordinary since work on the renovation of the Christ Church Parish House and the campus will begin in October.

As noted in detail in last week's letter to the parish family, many of our activities except for worship will move to the Community Reformed Church. This will provide the opportunity not only to keep many of our programs in tact; it will also allow Christ Church and the Community Reformed Church to combine aspects of ministry that will enable our two churches to reach out more effectively to the community. Our common activities will start with joint Church School classes and youth activities for junior and senior high school students. In the latter area we will also work with the Congregational Church of Manhasset. Some of our smaller activities will move to the Rectory at 54 George Street. This will probably include meetings of the Vestry and other periodic small meetings.

We have requested use of the parking lot at Manhasset Library on Sunday mornings when the library is closed. Through the middle of October, the Christ Church parking lot will be available. As soon as construction begins, all of that will change. We **hope** there will be some parking available in the Christ Church parking lot during the renovation—but we can't be certain when and how many spaces will be available. Although we are welcome to leave our Church School students off at the Community Reformed Church, we should not park in their parking lot because the members of the Community Church will need parking for their service of worship. We will work out the details as the construction scenario evolves.

Our fall schedule commences on Sunday, September 9. The Church School will begin at 9:50 AM, but we suggest that students and their parents come to the Community Reformed Church's church hall at 9:30 AM for registration and orientation on the 9th. At the end of Church School (and the Eucharist at Christ Church), Father Lowry will go to the Reformed Church to officiate at the Church School Chapel service, which includes Communion for the students and teachers. The students, teachers and Father Lowry will then return to Christ Church for fellowship and refreshments in the church or, in good weather, outside the church. On September 9 we will plan to have our muchbeloved "Ice Cream Sunday."

There will be much more information in the September *Chart* about the exciting and sometimes perplexing period into which we are going. For the time-being, please note the other items in this *Chart* and have a blessed end of summer.
