Dear Friends,

We are now in the midst of Lent. By tradition, Lent is the time when Christians ask the important questions about their lives and their faith. Yet it is not a time for getting out our *hair-shirts*. Our reflection on faith is not intended to invoke shame or guilt. Lent is a time for making decisions about God's plan for our lives and our commitment to find ways to better realize the fullness of life in the Gospel. If fasting helps you in that process of personal discernment, that is great; you should keep to your Lenten fast. However, if fasting is undertaken as an end rather than a means to a greater spiritual exploration, it is of little or no value.

Life keeps getting busier. Much of the time it is filled with useful activities; but even useful activities can divert us from important activities. I am trying to use Lent as a time

to look at all the things I do and ask whether I should be doing all of them. There are times when I am trying to do so many things (most of which are good) that I believe I am doing nothing terribly well—and that means I am not doing the best I can do. I hope that by the end of Lent I will have sorted out some of these issues and I will be ready to celebrate new life in Christ.

I do have a few suggestions to make for Lent. First, take some quiet time. Think about your life: consider your relationships; ask whether you are using your time in a way you believe to be productive. Second, take some time for prayer. Praying does not need to be formal—it should be more from the heart than from the mind. Pray about what is most important to you. And third, find something you can do for someone else—someone who really needs your help.

I hope that some of these musings will help you have a genuinely blessed Lent—and be prepared for a truly joyful Easter.
