A Message from our Director of Spiritual Formation

The Great Conductor

Every holiday season, my family and I go to Christmas at POPS!, a thrilling evening of orchestral music by the Boston Symphony Orchestra. The concert includes soaring Christmas melodies, a touching musical rendition of 'Twas the Night Before Christmas, the Holly Jolly Sing Along! of favorite carols and a surprise visit from Santa Claus, who always has the audience simultaneously laughing and groaning at many unamusing holiday jokes.

I love arriving early to admire the beautiful Christmas decorations and lights in the majestic Symphony Hall. I love watching people, dressed in festive attire, bustling about. I love seeing young children, wide eyed in anticipation, staring up at the big stage. I love listening to the musicians warm up and tune their instruments, making a cacophony of conflicting sounds. My favorite part, however, is when the conductor walks on stage, bows to the audience, steps on the podium and picks up his baton. I know that the real magic is about to begin.

I have been told that conductors go to school as long as surgeons to learn and perfect their craft. They must know every instrument intimately and understand each sound, shape and ability. They can hear music before it is played, and with their skilled baton, they guide each individual instrument to make its unique noise at the perfect tempo, tone, pitch and dynamic to create an extraordinary masterpiece of sound.

In a very similar way, God is our conductor, and we are His musicians. God created each of us with unique spiritual gifts - diverse sounds, shapes and abilities - to use in the world. Just like the violin, piccolo, cello, french horn, oboe, tuba and drums, we all have a special part to play in God's great orchestra. God knows each of us intimately and guides us, with His loving hands, to always create our perfect sounds.

This Christmas, let's remember the magic of sharing our special gifts with each other and the world. Whether leading, serving, teaching, praying, encouraging, worshipping, guiding, singing, giving or loving, this is the time, the holy advent season, to use our individual blessings to create an extraordinary masterpiece of sound. I know that if we do, it will be music to God's ears!
